*“What a wildly wonderful world, God!
You made it all, with Wisdom at your side,

“What a wildly wonderful world...” The Message translation of these verses from Psalm 104 captures the Psalmist’s almost uncontrollable awe at the great diversity, intricacy, and vastness of creation. Just as the James Webb Space Telescope (JWST) recently has shown us the wonders of distant galaxies and cosmic phenomena, these verses celebrate the Creator’s wisdom and the intentional and complex design of our universe. Science and spirituality are aligned, inviting us to marvel at the grandeur of God’s creation around us

The striking images provided by the James Webb Space Telescope reinforce the themes of Psalm 104, illustrating the vastness, complexity, and beauty of God’s creation. The telescope’s discoveries evoke a sense of awe and reverence, encouraging a deeper appreciation for the mysteries of the universe and the greatness of the Creator. As we explore the cosmos, we are continually reminded of the intricate and magnificent work of God, inspiring us to join the psalmist in praise and wonder at the marvels of creation. And here I invite you to read Psalm 104, especially verses 10-30.

*I will sing to the Lord all my life;
I will sing praise to my God as long as I live.
May my meditation be pleasing to him,
as I rejoice in the Lord. them? (Psalm 104:33-34, NIV)*
